Section 14. Item for Meetings

2. **Except as provided in this section,** all agenda items must be approved by the Chair, for inclusion on the agenda. The Chair may, in consultation with the County Administrator, use his/her discretion in placing and scheduling items for the agenda, provided the Chair may not unreasonably delay placing items on the agenda requested by other Commissioners. All Commissioners may suggest items for future agendas during regular meetings at the time designated for that purpose and at other times. **Any agenda item shall also be placed on the next meeting's agenda upon a vote of four or more members.**

Section 15. Chair to be Presiding Officer

The Chair shall take the chair at the time appointed for the meeting, call the members to order, cause the roll to be called, and, a quorum being present, proceed to business.

The Chair serves at the pleasure of the Board. The Chair may be overruled on any matter by a vote of four Board members. The Chair may be removed or replaced at any time by a vote of four members.
