Section 14. Item for Meetings

2. Except as provided in this section, all agenda items must be approved by the Chair for inclusion on the agenda. All Commissioners may suggest items for future agendas during regular meetings at the time designated for that purpose and at other times. The Chair may, in consultation with the County Administrator, use his/her discretion in placing and scheduling items for the agenda., provided the Chair may not unreasonably delay placing items on the agenda requested by other Commissioners. All Commissioners may suggest items for future agendas during regular meetings at the time designated for that purpose and at other times. Any agenda item shall also be placed on the next meeting's agenda upon a vote of four or more board members. An item shall also be placed on the next meeting agenda if a Commissioner submits a written request signed by three or more Commissioners to the Administrator on or before noon seven days before the day of any meeting.
